CreateHere is pleased to announce this year's MakeWork art grant awards. Fourteen recipients from a variety of creative disciplines received individual grants totaling \$100,000. This year 126 Chattanooga area artists and artisans applied for these competitive grants, requesting just over \$1.3 million in total funding. Juries comprised of artists, professionals, and community leaders reviewed applications and awarded funding.

The grant program is open to emerging and established artists and artisans living within a 50-mile radius of Chattanooga.

The core mission of the program is to stimulate our city's creative economy and

empower artists and artisans with the tools they need to succeed and grow. Creatives are eligible for

assistance for studio rental, tools, workshops, and those “someday-I’d-love-to” projects.

These 14 individuals will join a group 69 artists strong, all of whom have received funding through MakeWork since its debut in 2008. Since that time, the program has awarded over \$665,000 to support creative endeavors.
